

ANIMAL EQUIPMENT & ACCESSORIES - Section X

ANIMAL EQUIPMENT & ACCESSORIES RULES

- a) This section includes any handmade item used for the care, grooming, tack, or caging of livestock or pets (exception: sewn items are included in Section O, Class #3).
- b) Included with each entry a 3" x 5" card stating (1) where the item is to be used, (2) what the item will be used for, and (3) the resource(s) you used to make/construct the item (name of the 4-H project book, for example).
- c) Exhibits must be completed by the 4-H exhibitor, not purchased.
- d) All exhibits must be made during the current club year and since the last Erie County Fair.
- e) Exhibits must be clean and in good condition to be accepted as a fair entry.
- f) Exhibits will be evaluated on their suitability for intended purpose.
- g) All exhibits must remain in the 4-H Youth Development Building for the duration of the Fair.
- h) There is no maximum number of entries per class in this section. However, if there is more than one entry, each must be distinctly different variety or technique/materials.

Classes 1 - 11

Class

1. **Cages or Carriers** – (1) craftsmanship of the item and (2) suitability for its stated purpose will be used in evaluating the exhibit.
2. **Grooming Kit** – Grooming equipment must be included.
3. **Nest Boxes, Ringing Shelf, Incubators or Hatchers, Wooden Feed Boxes**
4. **Leashes, Halters, Collars, Lead Rope, Lunge Lines** – Choice of material will be considered in evaluating the exhibit.
5. **Waterer**
6. **Pet Food Treats** – such as homemade dog biscuits. Include recipe and nutritional information.
7. **Pet Toy or Training Device**
8. **Tack Box**
9. **Feeder**
10. **Working equipment** - such as goat cart
11. **Non-Sewn Item not listed above.**

**Sewn pet accessories such as blankets, saddle bags and backpacks are entered in Section O, Class #3.
