4. Antiques are defined in this section as being 75 years old or older (1935). No reproductions will be knowingly accepted nor will they be eligible for judging. Bubble wrap articles or items with bar codes will not be accepted.
5. The director of the section or the designee, reserves the right to reject an item or items.
6. Articles inappropriately classified (age or type) may be disqualified from acceptance by the director or designee and, as such, will be required to be removed from the section.
7. Display of articles in the section will be at the discretion of the director, designee, and/or the judge, and may be displayed in another appropriate section as deemed fit by such individuals.
