AQUARIA RULES

- a) There is no maximum number of entries in these classes. When more than one (1) entry is exhibited in a class, each must be of a different variety and be distinctly different.
- b) All Aquaria entries must arrive Saturday, August 7, 2010 for participants to set up their exhibit in the 4-H Youth Development Building. Judging will be on Saturday. No exhibit may be picked up before Monday, August 23rd.
- c) All exhibits **must have a 3" x 5" index card with detailed care instructions and a labeled supply of food.**

Class#

1. **Betta Bowl** – Entry must follow the guidelines of the Betta Bowl 4-H Project, available from the 4-H Office.
2. **Bowl Aquarium** – Using a 1-gallon glass drum or bowl, gravel, live or artificial aquatic plants and at least one live fish, create a miniature aquarium that has an environment that is healthy for the fish. May include a light for illumination.
3. **Aquarium** – A balanced aquarium of live fish created by the exhibitor. The aquarium can be of native or tropical fish and plants. Aquariums will be judged on the excellence of environment and vigor of fish. Must be a 10-gallon set-up. May use live or artificial plants that are compatible.
4. **Theme Bowl or Aquarium** – Using bowl or aquarium requirements from classes #2 or #3, create an exhibit that incorporates a theme.
