General Clothing Design & Construction Rules

1. Please read and abide by The Erie County Fair and Creative Arts Department rules and regulations.
2. All entries must be pre-registered by Friday, July 23, 2010. Entries not pre-registered will not be accepted. For more information see the Important Entry Information page.
3. Articles judged on the following points: Fine workmanship, suitability of article to purpose and design, harmony of color and materials, creativity, and originality of design.
4. Condition of work must be clean, well pressed, on hangers, and not noticeably worn, stained or spotted.
5. No name label allowed.
6. Hangers and garment bags must be labeled if you wish to have them returned. It is preferable that the exhibitor's keep special hangers or garment bags, as storage space is limited.
7. All garments in this section must be hand made; purchased garments will not be accepted.

CURRENT DESIGN CLASSES

1. Creative Fabric Garment; Self-designed fabric, e.g.: batik, hand stitched, embroidered, quilted, painted trapunto, beaded - wearable art
2. French Hand/Machine Sewing (Heirloom sewing)
3. Original Design Garment; constructed without a pattern
4. Garment using designer pattern. Pattern must accompany
5. Costume – Child, Adult or Pet
