General Youth Flower Show Rules

1. Please read and abide by all The Erie County Fair and Creative Arts Department rules and regulations.
2. All entries must be pre-registered with the Fair office by Friday, July 23, 2010. Entries not pre-registered will not be accepted. For more information see the Important Entry Information page.
3. Sections SA, SB, and SC are open to youth exhibitors from the ages 8 – 17.
4. A youth exhibitor is limited to a total of six (6) entries, only one entry in each class.
5. All work is to be done by the exhibitor.
6. No artificial plant material permitted.
7. Container grown plants must have been in the possession of the exhibitor for two months.
8. The youth floral design and horticulture section will be displayed as part of the adult flower show in the Creative Arts Building.
