
FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Q:** What happens if I put my entry in my mailbox on Monday, July 12, 2010?
A: *Your Fair Entry MUST be received on or before July 12, 2010 @ 7:00 PM. This includes postal and personal delivery to office. FAXED ENTRIES AND E-MAILED RESPONSES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.*
- Q:** How do I know if the office received my entry on time?
A: *On the Fair Entry, there are instructions to include a self-addressed stamped envelope. When the office receives your Fair entry with the envelope included, they will mail confirmation back to you. YOU MUST include the self-addressed stamped envelope to receive the information.*
- Q:** When and where do I bring my 4-H Youth Development Building entry to be evaluated?
A: *In the July 4-H news there will be a schedule of evaluation times on line at www.cce.cornell.edu/erie. ALL entries are brought to the 4-H Youth Development Building on The Fairgrounds on Saturday, August 7, 2010.*
- Q:** What should I do if I cannot bring my 4-H Youth Development Building entry to be evaluated?
A: *You can have another person bring your entries if absolutely necessary. The 4-H Office strongly urges you to bring in your own entries because evaluators are able to offer constructive comments on the quality of your work. As noted, if not present, the exhibitor MUST answer questions about the entry on an accompanying 3"x5" index card for quality.*
- Q:** Is it okay to put information on notebook paper or on a 4" x 6" index card instead of a 3" x 5" index card?
A: *Yes, another sized paper can be substituted for the 3"x5" index card. The answers should be in the child's own words and provided in the child's handwriting when possible. Recipes may be photocopied.*
- Q:** What happens if I enter an item in the wrong class?
A: *The evaluator will ask you to have it corrected through the person in charge of entries and the entry will then be evaluated but the premium will be reduced. If you have questions concerning the proper section/class, contact the 4-H office to arrange a time to bring the item to the office for help in answering your question. This should be done prior to July 1st.*
- Q:** When and where do I pick up my premium check?
A: *All premium checks (livestock & 4-H Youth Development Building exhibits) are available the last Sunday of the Fair, August 22nd, from 5:00 PM until 7:00 PM in the Livestock Complex Office. They will also be released on Monday, August 23rd, the day after the Fair in the Youth Development Building from 1:00 PM until 6:00 PM. All adjustments to premium awards must be made on Sunday and Monday during hours noted. All checks must be cashed within 60 days of the check's date or they will be forfeited to the Erie County Agricultural Society.*
- Q:** When do I pick up my 4-H Youth Development Building Entry and what happens if I am unable to be there?
A: *Entries MUST be picked up on Monday, August 23rd the day after the Fair from 1:00 PM until 6:00 PM. You MUST make arrangements to have your item(s) picked up by someone on Monday, August 23rd, if you are not available that day. If not, they may be left in an unsecured building, and neither the Erie County 4-H nor the Fairgrounds will claim responsibility for them. Thank you for your cooperation.*
