GOAT RULES

- a) All goat health records must accompany animals to the Fair.
- b) Goats must have an ear tag or tattoo number that is to be used as positive identification on the official goat entry form and health papers.
- c) The Interdepartmental Rabies Committee (NYS Health Department, Department of Environmental Conservation and Department of Agriculture and Markets) recommends appropriate off-label rabies vaccine by a licensed veterinarian. This is subject to change upon approval of a vaccine for goats.
- d) Goats may be purebred or recorded grade.
- e) Any animal showing an open sore may not be exhibited. Any animal that produces an open sore while at the fair will be sent home immediately.
- f) Herd and/or dairy signs will be permitted.
- g) **Exhibitors must show in FFA official dress.**
- h) **All exhibitors are responsible for maintaining their exhibit until release on Sunday, August 22, 2010. Failure to do so will result in not being able to participate in The Erie County Fair in the future and forfeiture of premium checks.**

MARKET MEAT GOAT REGULATIONS

- a) Market Meat Goats must be born since October 1, 2009.
- b) Market Meat Goats must weigh a minimum of 60 lbs at time of Fair weigh-in, or they will not be eligible for the show or sale. All goats will be weighed one time only and no substitutions will be allowed.
- c) All animals must be owned and cared for by the exhibitor since May 1, 2010.
- d) All meat goats must be either a wether or a doe. Acceptable breeds are Nubian, Kiko, Boer, Spanish, Savannah, Myotonic or crosses of these and may be purebred or grade.
- e) There must be a minimum of 5 market meat goats to hold an official auction.
- f) Market goats must have been administered a rabies vaccine on or before July 20, 2010 in order to adhere to the 21 days withholding.

BREEDING MEAT GOAT REGULATIONS

- a) All animals must be owned and cared for by exhibitor since May 1, 2010
- b) All animals, registered or non-registered, must have proper identification. Non-registered animals are required to have a scrapie tag.
- c) Animals shown in the market meat goat class are NOT eligible to show in the breeding classes.
- d) The base date for ages is the date of the show.

Section A- Registered, Full blood

Section B- Percentage, Unregistered

- 1) Doe Kid under 6 months
- 2) Doe Kid 6 months – under 12 months
- 3) Doe 12 months – 2 years
- 4) Doe 3 years and older

MEAT GOATS

Section L, Class #1 – Project Market Meat Goat

Goats will be divided into light, medium and heavy weight classes after they are weighed. All market meat goats will be weighed upon arrival at the Showplex. All animals exhibited in this class will be sold at the Meat Goat Auction on Saturday, August 22, 2010 at 1:00 pm.

MEAT GOAT SHOWMANSHIP

Awards: Blue \$3.00 Red \$2.00 White \$1.00

Class #

1. Novice Meat Goat Showmanship – Open to first year exhibitors, with no prior experience in showing and fitting dairy goats.

2. Junior Meat Goat Showmanship – 8 – 13 years

3. Senior Meat Goat Showmanship – 14 – 19 years

4. Alumni Meat Goat Showmanship – 20 & 21 years old

Champion Meat Goat Showman - Previous winners of Championship not eligible for this award, they must compete in the age class in which they would normally compete in. Entries for this class are limited to the 1st place showman in classes 1-3 and the 1st place alumni showman.

6. Junior Breeding Meat Goat Showmanship – 8 – 13 years

7. Senior Breeding Meat Goat Showmanship – 14 – 19 years

8. Alumni Breeding Meat Goat Showmanship – 20 & 21 years old

Champion Breeding Meat Goat Showman- Previous winners of Championship not eligible for this award, they must compete in the age class in which they would normally compete in. Entries for this class are limited to the 1st place showman in classes 1-3 and the 1st place alumni showman.

Champion Goat Showman – To consist of the 2010 Champion Meat Goat Showman and the 2010 Champion Breeding Meat Goat Showman.

9. Master Goat Showman – Entries limited to previous Erie County Fair Dairy and Non-Dairy Goat Master Showman and 2010 Champion Goat Showman.
