### General Quilt Exhibit Rules

1. Please read and abide by all The Erie County Fair and Creative Arts Department rules and regulations.
2. All entries must be pre-registered by Friday, July 23, 2010. Entries not pre-registered will not be accepted. For more information see the Important Entry Information page.
3. **Piecing and quilting must have been done by the exhibitor, using home sewing machine. For quilts stitched using professional quilting machines see classes 31 – 55.**
4. Condition of work MUST be clean and not noticeably worn.
5. Pre-quilted fabric will not be accepted.
6. Please cover name labels
7. No wall hangings or quilts with a rod pocket or “quillos”. A small quilt with a rod pocket constitutes a “wall-hanging”.
8. Quilts must be at least a twin bed size; except for the child quilt classes, which should be crib size.
9. For quilts with odd measurements the director will need to see them on entry day to see where they fit best.
