# Standard Electric Service Rules and Regulations

- 1.** All equipment, regardless of source of power, must comply with the current National Electric Code, State and Local Safety Codes.
- 2.** All equipment must be properly tagged or marked with complete information as to the type and/or amount of amperage, voltage etc. required.
- 3.** All exhibitors' 120 volt cords must be of the 2 wire, grounded type. All exposed non-current carrying metal parts of fixed equipment, which are liable to be energized, shall be grounded.
- 4.** The Fairgrounds reserves the right to refuse any connection to any exhibitor whose equipment is deemed unsafe by the electrical supervisor.
- 5.** Permanent building electrical outlets are not part of booth space and are not to be used by exhibitors unless specified otherwise.
- 6.** A. All Service connections and overload protection to such equipment must be made by "Fairgrounds Electrician" only.  
B. Payment in full must be received by prior to electrical service connection.
- 7.** The Fairgrounds is not responsible for voltage fluctuation or power failure for temporary conditions. Surge protection is the responsibility for exhibitor.
- 8.** Payment in full must be received prior to electrical service connection.
- 9.** Advance orders are those orders received by June 1, 2009 and paid in full. These orders receive priority service.
- 10.** Unauthorized power not paid for will result in shutdown of electrical service. To get your electrical service restored, you must pay the onsite fee for the proper amperage plus a 25% penalty.
- 11.** Exhibitors supplying their own breaker boxes (must be pre-wired) are required to have service cord that is a minimum of 75 feet long. (SO cord only)
- 12.** Extension cords will not be supplied to any outdoor exhibitors. If cords are needed, it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to supply their own cords.
- 13.** Claims will not be considered unless filed by exhibitor prior to close of the event.
